





# Island living, cat style





Register, microchip, de-sex and confine your cat on Kangaroo Island

## Domestic cats on KI must be:

-  registered with KI Council
-  identified with a microchip
-  de-sexed unless a registered breeding animal
-  confined within the owner's property.

If you are bringing your cat to Kangaroo Island, you must notify KI Council.

## Why?

-  Lost, impounded or trapped cats can be returned to their owners.
-  De-sexed cats live longer and have healthier lives, and don't produce unwanted cats.
-  Cats in enclosures are safe and happy and the environment is protected.
-  Cats kill native animals and spread diseases to sheep.
